Recipe Corner

Slow Cooker Kielbasa and Barbecue Beans

INGREDIENTS

- 2 15 oz cans black beans, drained and rinsed
- 2 15.8 oz Great Norther beans, drained and rinsed
- 1 15.25 oz can kidney beans, drained and rinsed
- 1 onion, diced
- ½ cup barbecue sauce
- ¾ cup ketchup
- 1 tbsp Worcestershire sauce
- 1 tbsp mustard
- 1 tsp chili powder
- 1 tbsp apple cider vinegar
- ½ cup maple syrup
- ¼ cup molasses
- 1 14.5 oz can chicken broth
- 1/2 lb bacon, cooked, cut into bite size pieces
- 2 lbs Kielbasa, cut into bite size pieces

INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. In a large slow cooker, add all of the ingredients except for the kielbasa and stir gently to combine.
- 1. Place the kielbasa on top and cover with the lid.
- 2. Cook on low for 6 to 8 hours or high for 4 to 5 hours. Stir in the kielbasa before serving.

Notes:

I recommend the low setting for this recipe because on high, the beans tend to get dried out. If you need to cook on high due to time constraints, monitor the beans and add more broth or water if necessary.

Slow Cooker Creamy Tortellini Soup

INGREDIENTS

- 500 grams | 1 pound ground Italian sausage (or ground chicken, turkey or beef), browned
- 1 brown onion, chopped
- 2 large carrots, chopped
- 2 stalks celery, chopped
- 4 cloves garlic, minced
- 1 tablespoon Italian seasoning
- 2 teaspoon beef bouillon powder (or chicken)
- ½ teaspoon salt
- 4 cups beef broth (or chicken or vegetable broth -- I use low sodium)
- ¼ cup cornstarch mixed and dissolved in ¼ cup water
- 3x 340 gram | 12-ounce cans full fat evaporated milk or half and half
- 1x 340 gram | 12 ounce packet three cheese tortellini (I used dried not fresh; choose any flavour you like)
- 5 cups fresh baby spinach
- 1 cup milk
- 1. Place the browned sausage, onion, carrots, celery, garlic, Italian seasoning, beef bouillon powder, salt, and broth in a 6-quart / litre slow cooker bowl. Cover and cook on high for 4 hours or low for 7 hours.
- 2. Uncover and skim any fat that is sitting on the top of the soup with a spoon; discard. Stir in the cornstarch mixture with the evaporated milk (or half and half or cream). Add the tortellini and mix well. Cover again and cook on HIGH heat setting for a further 45 minutes until the soup has thickened, and the tortellini is soft and cooked through.
- 3. Add in the spinach, pressing the leaves down to completely submerse into the liquid. Cover again for a further 5-10 minutes until the leaves have wilted.
- 4. Pour in milk in ¹/₃ cup increments, as needed, to reach your desired thickness and consistency (I needed 1 cup); taste test and season with extra salt ONLY if needed, and pepper to suit your tastes.
- 5. Serve with crusty warmed bread

WHAT YOU NEED

- 2 x 235 mL (2 bottles) vanilla or chocolate PediaSure Complete[®], chilled

2017 Since 1996 the Evergreen Youth Centre has provided all child and youth programming, and has played a huge role in all family programming provided to the residents of Evergreen. Recently we have been trying to explain the urgency felt at the Youth Centre as we fast approach the fall of

2017.

April

In 2016 our FCSS funding was cut dramatically and as of September 2017 we will no longer have any funding from them. That effectively removes close to \$80,000 a year in children's programming from Evergreen right off the bat. Long time Executive Director, Alice Hobbins, will be leaving us in the fall when her position is abolished. Also happening in September is the removal of Boys & Girls Club programming from Evergreen. This decision, based on demographics and a lack of significant participation, means our after school program will be changing dramatically.
