# PRESIDENT'S CORNER

Thank you to everyone who took the time out of their busy schedules to attend our AGM on May 27th, the attendance was higher than we have seen in many years.

As posted on our FaceBook page, here it is in a nutshell (condensed version of events). When we first delivered the notice stating that the EECA may have to close its doors it was for a couple of reasons. We had been given notice that our rent was increasing and they were adding in a utility cost that was almost as much as the rent. Including almost \$12,0000 in back utilities for 2018. The utility cost was for water, sewer, exterior lights and storm drainage for the Hall and the Seniors Centre. With limited funds, as we are a non-profit organization we were not sure how we were going to manage this. After sending a letter to Parkbridge and getting our City Councilor Aaron Paquette, the Mayors office and MLA involved we were asked to come in and meet with Parkbridge. It was at this meeting that we were informed we would be getting our spaces rent free. We are still required to pay the utility costs going forward but the 2018 costs were covered by Parkbridge. Our other reason was lack of community participation and volunteers. Last night we acquired not one but 2 new board members from the community which is awesome and we are super excited. Thank you again for your participation at our AGM your concerns did not go unheard. The Board will be planning a Town Hall meeting in the near future for all residents to discuss community concerns with City Councilors and MLA's. We will keep you posted once we can confirm dates etc.

I will continue to post updates on our FaceBook page and as we re-vamp our website we will be posting more information on there as well.





#### A GUIDE FOR PARENTS

Alberta is one of the safest places in the world to live, work and play. To help make it and even safer place for your children, these safety tips have been complied to help prepare both parents and children to deal with threatening situations.

Have your children practice their full name, full address and phone number. They should know your full name and work number as well. Make a game of it. Shake their hand and start with "How do you do? I am your Mom/Dad, who are you?" This game can be started with children as young two years old.

Create a family secret code. Children should never go with anyone, not even a close family friend, unless they have been told the code. Change the code immediately after it has been used. Make the code easy, and fun, to remember. I.E. Fluffy Pink Bunny

Children should always travel the same way to and from school, the park, etc. They should never talk shortcuts, if possible have them walk in pairs or groups

If someone follows your child in a car, they should turn around and get away in the opposite direction the car is facing. Run home, to a Safe Parent home or the nearest public place such as a school, store or office. Your child should also try to remember what the driver and car looked or its license plate number. They can take a picture of it with their cell phone.

If your child becomes separated from you in a store or shopping mall, tell them to go directly to a store employee (the person at the cash register) to help.

Give your child permission to say "NO" to an adult and run away if they are in an uncomfortable position.

NEVER leave a young child alone!! An unattended child is a child at risk.




