Greetings fellow gardeners!

The weeds are slowing down, the sunflowers golden, and the zucchinis, cucumbers and tomatoes are ripening by the dozens.

We are enjoying the fruits of our labour and enjoying the summer before the fall garden cleansing begins. A great idea is to take done pictures in your garden now so that when little leaves pop up next spring you'll remember just how much those delphiniums overtook that bleeding heart, or that the strange little plant in the corner actually is an echinacea. Don't forget to give those containers a little bit if fertilizer to keep them blooming until the frost. Don't forget to "dead-head" (remove spent blooms) as this will help the plant to keep producing new blossoms.



At the last minute our speaker on small gardens cancelled for our August meeting. Although disappointed, Garden Club members always have plenty to talk about and we had a lovely horticultural discussion regardless. Next month we have a speaker on birds specific to the Evergreen area. A lot of gardeners are birders, too, and will find the information quite interesting. Back to school safety

Alberta Health Services EMS would like to remind parents and students about some road safety tips, as streets become more congested, with the return of the school year. Pedestrians and motorists both have an important role to play – road safety is a shared responsibility.

Motorists

- Avoid talking on cell phones, texting, or any other behavior that diverts your attention away from driving.
- Give right-of-way to pedestrians who have activated overhead crossing lights, or who are waiting to cross from a street corner.
- Remember, it is illegal to pass vehicles - other than those that are parked - in school zones or playground zones, during posted hours.

Around school buses

- Flashing amber lights mean a bus is slowing down to stop – motorists should do likewise.
- No matter which direction you are coming from, STOP, when approaching a school bus with activated flashing red lights – unless the bus is on the opposite side of a divided highway from you.
- Driver courtesy goes a long way. By simply being alert and cautious when approaching a school bus, you are contributing to school bus safety.

Pedestrians

- Cross only at marked crosswalks, or street corners that have clear visibility from all directions.
- Make eye contact with all drivers before crossing the street.
- When activating overhead crossing lights, pause before stepping off the curb to ensure motorists in both directions have come to a complete stop.
- Stay within the crosswalk lines until fully clear of the roadway.
- Obey pedestrian lights at intersections. Cross the street only when you see the 'walk' sign and only when all cars have come to a complete stop.
- If you are with young children or pets, hold your child's hand firmly and keep a solid grip on leashes when crossing.
- Remember: children learn by observing. By demonstrating safe crossing habits, you can reduce the chances of your child being involved in a preventable auto/pedestrian collision.


