It is with regret that the Evergreen Community Association announces that due to a lack of General Funds, we have been forced to lay off our Association Clerk. We have been one of the lucky communities who have had enough General Funds to pay someone to help with the mountain of volunteer work required to run an active Community such as ours. Many communities, including ours, were hit with an ALGC (Alberta Liquor and Gaming Commission) audit and their interpretation of Gaming Proceeds differed from ours, and we have had to pay back into Gaming Funds from General Funds, which has left us with a balance of less than \$1,000 in General Funds. Please bear with us over the next few weeks as we regroup and delegate the paid Association Clerk's duties amongst our volunteer Board.

The Community Association is not lacking in Gaming Funds and will continue to provide programs for our members like the Seniors Club, the Garden Club, Darts, Crib, TOTS and TOPS. We will still be hosting community events like Canada Day, the Block Party / Membership Drive, the Community-Wide Garage Sale in August, the Kid's Christmas Party, and so much more. Gaming Funds are just not allowed to be used for the wages of an Association Clerk. The new board will be working hard to explore new fundraising methods over the next year. Keep your eye on the newsletter for more updates.

Backyard Play Safetv

With summer fast approaching, Alberta Health Services EMS would like to encourage parents to ensure their backyard play areas are made safe. Direct supervision is the best method to reduce the chance of injury. It is also prudent to ensure play equipment in your yard is suitable for the age and skill of the children using it. Don't forget to check the equipment often and repair any worn or broken parts. Set up play equipment on 8 to 12 inches of a shock-absorbing surface such as sand, wood chips, or pea gravel. Grass will not adequately cushion a fall.

Water hazards

- Ensure all backyard swimming pools are fenced. The fence should be at least 1.5 metres (5 feet) high and have a selflatching, self-closing, lockable gate;
- Drowning is the leading cause of unintentional injury-related death among children ages one to four;
- Children can drown in just a few centimetres of water if it covers their mouth and nose

Lawn and garden tools

- Keep young children away from outdoor power equipment. Serious burns may result from touching hot engine surfaces;
- Ensure that all tools, fuel, chemicals, and other hazardous substances are stored in a secure, locked area. A simple latch may not be sufficient.

- Insect bites and stings
- · Minimize the risk of attracting insects by not wearing strong
- perfumes or scented lotions; Avoid wearing brightly coloured clothing outdoors:
- Destroy or re-locate hives and nests situated near your home;
- To avoid a bite in case of accidentally stepping on a stinging insect always ensure you child wears shoes or
- sandals: If your child has received an 'EpiPenJr' prescription from your physician (for serious anaphylactic emergencies only)
- ensure they understand when and how to use it: If your child experiences a
- severe reaction to an insect sting, seek medical attention or call 9-1-1



What can I do if I'm being cyber bullied?

- Do not tolerate it! Block the email address or cell phone number and delete the sender from your contacts.
- Report all bullying activities to the internet service provider (ISP) or web site they occur on. Many websites including Facebook and YouTube have safety centers to report cyber bullying.
- Tell an adult you trust about what's going on. Keep talking about it until you get someone to help you.
- Don't delete any of the emails, texts, or messages, all are evidence if the police need to be involved. Keep a record of any bullying occurrences.
- Never forward any mean messages that spread rumors about you or anyone else.
- Never retaliate or cyber bully back. Revenge is never an appropriate answer and may serve to worsen the situation.
- Always be civil while standing up for yourself. Don't sink to the bully's level.
- Recognize that you don't deserve to be treated this way. Demand respect.




