





Complete Game Baseball provides full day and half day summer camp options through NEZ Sports Council. Camps must meet a minimum number of campers per week to run and will maintain excellent camper to coach ratios.

Early drop off: 8:00am - 9:00am Full Day Camp: 9:00am - 4:00pm Late pick up: 4:00pm - 5:00pm

Campers will be split in half based on age for baseball activities in the batting cage field house area and camp activities in the clubhouse area. To maintain excitement and participation, camp and baseball activities will be intermixed in both the mornings and afternoons. Baseball activities are based on the Baseball Canada Rally Cap. 


