



Recipe Corner



Hot Artichoke and Crab Dip

WHAT YOU NEED:

- 1 (8 ounce) package cream cheese, softened
- 1 cup mayonnaise
- 1 clove garlic, pressed
- 1 (14 ounce) can artichoke hearts in water, drained and chopped
- 1 1/2 cups cooked crabmeat
- 3/4 cup grated Parmesan cheese
- 1/3 cup chopped green onion
- 1/3 cup chopped red bell pepper
- 1 teaspoon ground cayenne pepper
- 1/2 cup dry bread crumbs



- 1. Preheat oven to 350 degrees F (175 degrees C).
- 2. Combine cream cheese and mayonnaise in a large bowl until smooth; stir in garlic. Gently stir artichoke hearts, crab, Parmesan cheese, 1/3 cup green onion, 1/3 cup red bell pepper, and cayenne pepper into cream cheese mixture. Transfer the dip to a 9-inch pie dish and sprinkle top with bread crumbs.
- 3. Bake in the preheated oven until crumb topping is golden brown and dip is hot, 20 to 30 minutes. Garnish with 2 teaspoons green onion and 2 teaspoons chopped red bell pepper.

Easy Homemade Snowman Craft



Craft Corner - KIDS



You Will Need:

White sock
Polyester stuffing
Red Yarn
Scissors
Felt or foam (for eyes/ buttons)
Orange pipe cleaner/ felt/ or orange paper (Nose)
Craft glue

What To Do:

- 1. Put a small amount of stuffing in the sock and tie off to shape the head.
- 2. Add a larger amount of stuffing for the next Snowman section and also tie off. Bottom section will, of course, require the most stuffing.
- 3. After bottom is stuffed, you can just poke the end of the sock into the stuffing, as it will hold in place. You can cut a round, white cardboard base and glue snowman to base if you want a more secure bottom.
- 4. Cut about 6 pieces of yarn, 12 inch lengths and tie around Snowman neck for his scarf.
- 5. Cut pieces of felt or foam for eyes and buttons and glue in place.
- 6. Use whatever you have to make a nose. We took a small section of pipe cleaner and bent in half and glued this in place. A scrap of felt or even a piece of paper, colored orange will work also.

Cream Cheese Penguins

BE SURE TO HAVE AN ADULT ASSIST YOU WITH ANY CUTTING

WHAT YOU NEED: 18 jumbo black olives, pitted 1 (8 ounce) package cream cheese, softened 18 small black olives Small Red Pepper



- Cut a slit from top to bottom, lengthwise, into the side of each jumbo olive. Carefully insert about 1
 teaspoon of cream cheese into each olive. Slice the carrot into eighteen 1/4 inch thick rounds; cut a
 small notch out of each carrot slice to form feet. Save the cut out piece and press into center of small
 olive to form the beak. If necessary cut a small slit into each olive before inserting the beak. Cut small
 thin sections of red pepper for the scarf.
- 2. Set a big olive, large hole side down, onto a carrot slice. Then, set a small olive onto the large olive, adjusting so that the beak, cream cheese chest and notch in the carrot slice line up. Secure with a toothpick. Add red pepper scarf.
