




## **Recipe Corner**



#### **BALSAMIC PORK ROAST - SLOW COOKER**

INGREDIENTS 1 (3 pound) boneless center cut pork roast 1 cup chicken broth ½ cup balsamic vinegar 1 tablespoon Worcestershire sauce 1 tablespoon soy sauce 1 tablespoon honey ½ teaspoon red pepper flakes ½ teaspoon Italian seasoning





Place pork roast in your slow cooker (fat side up). In a small bowl, whisk together remaining ingredients. Pour over the pork roast.

Cook for 6-8 hours on low setting. Ladle balsamic sauce on top of roast before serving. Serve with potatoes, rice or salad.

#### Mixed Corn & Bean Salad

- 1 can of green giant corn
- 1 can mixed beans
- 1 can heart of palm and cut into half inch pieces
- 1 can of button mushrooms
- 1 red onion finely chopped
- 1 red pepper finely chopped
- 1 green pepper finely chopped
- 4 celery stalks finely chopped
- 1 small bottle of Kraft Italian dressing
- You can add other ingredients like; cucumbers,
- Cauliflower, tomatoes whatever you feel like.

Mix all the above together and put in fridge overnight.

Our executive meeting will be soon and our schedule for 2017 imagined and solidified.



## February Is Heart Month



Do you know the signs and symptoms of a heart attack and what to do if someone experiences these? Knowing can make the difference between life and death. Recognizing and responding immediately to the warning signs of a potential heart attack can significantly improve survival and recovery. **February is Heart Month** - take the time to be heart safe and learn how you can reduce your risk.

#### Know the signs of a heart attack

(Any, or all, of these signs & symptoms may occur)

- Chest discomfort described as crushing, squeezing, pressure, or heaviness;
- Discomfort that moves beyond the chest, such as the shoulder, arm, neck, or jaw;
- Shortness of breath, sweating, or nausea and vomiting.

#### **Reduce your risk**

Heart attack risk factors include:

- Obesity\*
- Sedentary lifestyle\*
- Smoking\*
- High cholesterol\*
- Age / gender
- Family history

Speak with your doctor about how to treat your modifiable (\*) risk factors and learn to be heart safe.

#### What to do when seconds count

- Call 9-1-1 immediately. Early treatment can greatly reduce heart damage and make the difference of life and death;
- Treatment starts the moment EMS arrives. Paramedics can provide oxygen, start an intravenous and perform an electrocardiogram (ECG);
- Paramedics can also administer important medication(s) in the early minutes of a heart attack to lessen heart damage;
- During transport, EMS will share information with the hospital, so definitive treatment can begin immediately upon arrival;
- Take a CPR/AED (automated external defibrillator) course. Training is widely available from many reputable organizations. It's easy, inexpensive, and only takes a few hours.

# EECA SKATING RINK

- Helmet is required for all skaters under 17 years of age.
- Rink is closed when temperature (with or without wind chill) reaches minus 20 degrees or when the temperature is warmer than 0. The Facility operator may also close the rink as deemed necessary by weather or rink conditions.
- Concession open during official rink hours of operation.

Re: BABYSITTING TRAINING!!

Is your child excited about learning about Babysitting? Are they ever left home alone? There is a very exciting course coming up that can benefit everyone aged 11 years or older. There appears to be a keen interest in offering the youth of Evergreen a Babysitting Course! The Youth Centre has looked into the program and is pleased to have **Second Chance CPR and First Aid** offer the <u>Babysitting Course</u>.

To try and accommodate the very busy schedule of most families, the Babysitting Course will be offered on **Sunday**, **February 26th** from **(8:30 a.m. – 4:30 p.m)**, to meet the 8 hour total time requirements of the course. The details are on the following page.

Does your child baby-sit other children or their own brothers and sisters? Do you want to feel confident that they have learnt the skills to be left home alone to care for themselves?

A Babysitting course is a great way for young people to develop skills to better care for themselves and others. The course is available for students in grade 6 or older. Therefore, if you have sons or daughters that have **a genuine interest** in the course, they may register by adding their names to the registration form and returning it to the Youth Centre with a \$50 deposit (to be returned upon successful completion of the course), by **Wednesday**, **February 15th**.

The course consists of the following topics

- Rights and Responsibilities
- First Aid/CPR
- Skills for Caring
- Injury Prevention
- Skills for Getting Along
- Personal Safety and Security
- Safety
- Handling Emergencies

The following materials are included in the cost of the course:

- 1. Babysitter Manual (120 pages) and workbook
- 2. Certification Card
- 3. Babysitter Information Sheet.
