

# **Garden Club News**

Greetings fellow gardeners! Happy New Year! Rejoice that the days are already getting longer! Many members love to start planning in January, and some even start planting! If you have a cool east windowsill, this is the perfect place to start seedlings. You can make it work in warmer locations or facing different directions, but cool and east is your best bet for starting things indoors early. If the location is too warm, your plants will get "leggy", meaning their stems will get too long too quickly, and they will be weak and fall over.

Seedlings will follow the sun, so if they are in a west window they will always end the day leaning over, and you'll have to be very diligent in turning them. Facing east means the last time they see the sun it will be almost directly above them, so they will be standing tall at the end of the day. If they are in a south-facing window, they will grow too quickly, and will



also become "leggy". You will also have to rotate them frequently as they will always lean towards the window.

We hope you had a wonderful Christmas. The Garden Club had it's annual Christmas Pot Luck and Gift Exchange on December 21st at the hall. The variety of food this year was unbelievable and the gift exchange was a riot! All the gifts were garden-related and all members went home with a little something for their yards.

Our next meeting is VERY IMPORTANT. The Evergreen Garden Club has been a big part of this community for over a decade but it is in danger of becoming extinct in 2016. Our current executive is retiring for various personal reasons and all the positions are up for grabs. 
