



SKATE RINK HOURS AND INFORMATION

Rink Hours: Public Skate is 3:30 til 7:30 pm - Sunday to Thursday and Adult Skate is 7:30 to 9 pm (with the exception of Sunday of which it opens at Noon)! Friday, Saturdays, Holidays and No School Days , Public Skate from 12 noon til 8pm and Adult Skate is from 8 pm til 10 pm (with the exception of Friday opening which is 3:30 pm). Lights will be on from 4:30 til 10 pm





AHS Restrictions are in place <u>until further notice from both AHS and EFCL</u>, they do impact the way our Community ice rink and skate shack operate. "Only 10 people" maximum allowed on the ice for group physical activity outside your "cohort" or household and must maintain a 2 metre distance. *No Hockey, Shinny, including pick-up or tag games , competitions, events or any organized sport on the ice.* This is monitored by Skate Attendants and Rink Manager. Hockey sticks & pucks may be used as per Edmonton Bylaws but only sliding it on ice or hitting in the nets, plus during one on one training!!

A Bathroom is opened for use. <u>Skates and Helmets</u> are mandatory and if you need to borrow skates, please check with Skate attendant!

Skating Rink will be closed if outside temperature is above 5 degrees Celsius or including windchill temperature if below - 25 degrees Celsius

<u>"Wearing of Mask" is mandatory!! And "Social Distancing" rules must</u> <u>be followed !!</u>

New Skate Program on Wednesdays

Basic Skate Program: 5:30 to 6:30

Power Skate Program: 7:00 to 8:00 pm

Sign in sheet for program at the Skate Shack see attendant. Must be member to get free or there will be a fee!



EDMONTON CART ROLL OUT!

In spring 2021, how we sort, set out and collect waste is changing! All single unit homes and some multi-unit homes that currently receive residential curbside collection will be transitioned to a new automated cart collection service. These residents will use carts provided by the City of Edmonton to sort and set out their waste instead of placing bags at the curb. Each residential unit registered with Waste Services will receive a set of waste carts (one garbage and one food scraps cart).



Cart Delivery

Starts on March 15 and ends on April 10

You will receive your new carts between these two dates.



Cart Collection Service Starts the week of **April 13**

Do not set out your cart for collection before this date.

The new system includes four collections:

Food Scraps: collected weekly from spring to fall, and every 2 weeks in the winter, using a cart provided by the City. *If you have spare room in your food scraps cart, you can top it up with yard waste as long as the lid can be fully closed*

Recycling: Collected in blue bags all year round on a weekly basis. There are no changes to recycling collection

Garbage: Collected every 2 weeks year-round, using a cart provided by the City. Once you get the hang of sorting out your food scraps, yard waste and recycling, you'll find that you have less garbage.

Yard Waste: Collected twice in spring and twice in fall in clear plastic bags or double-ply paper yard waste bags and/or bundles wrapped in biodegradable twine. *You can also top up your food scraps cart with yard waste or take it to an Eco Station for free between seasonal collection days.*




