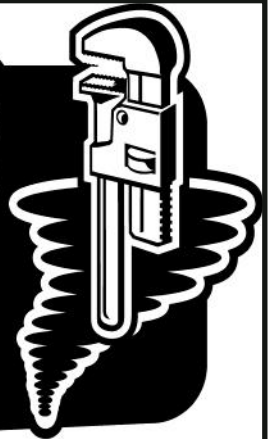

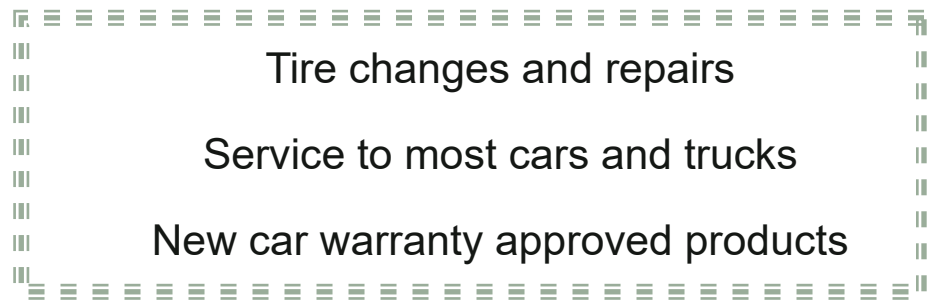

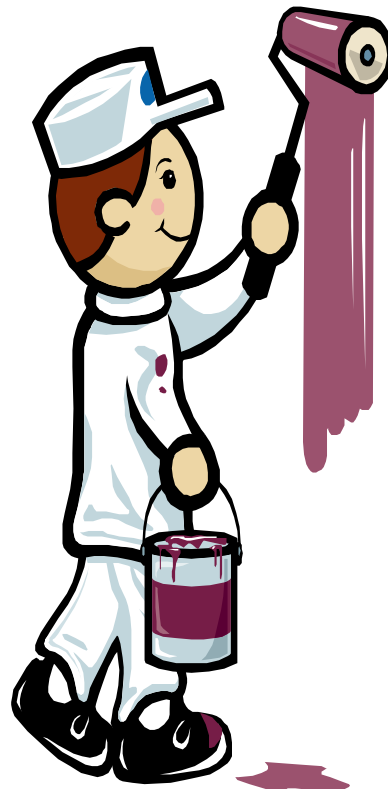

Transportation has been identified as a significant barrier to library use and epl2go gives us another way to reach out and be out and about in the community!

**What does epl2go offer?** epl2go offers great staff

There will not be a lending collection in the van, nor will the van be a place to pick up holds on library material; instead people of all ages can visit the van for a variety of fun and educational programs, to learn more about technology, to sign up for library memberships, to access the Internet and so much more.

There may be a select number of items to borrow depending on the program or event.

**Can the epl2go equipment be borrowed?**

No, the equipment remains with the van to support programs and activities around the city.

We are fortunate enough to have a pop up library right here in Evergreen at the Youth Centre every Monday from 6–7 p.m. following our EG After School program which also features an hour of library fun from 5–6 on Mondays.

Alberta Health Services EMS would like to remind parents and trick-or-treaters of some Halloween safety tips, as October 31<sup>st</sup> approaches. Halloween can be an exciting time for children, but with the distraction of treats and costumes, safety rules can easily be forgotten. Take some time to review these simple tips and reminders to help ensure Halloween is a safe night for everyone.

## Trick-or-Treaters

- Remember: all regular pedestrian rules still apply. Be sure to cross the road at marked cross walks, or well lit corners only. It is safest to work your way up one side of the street, and then cross once to the other side.
- Stay away from houses that are not well lit. Do not accept rides from strangers, or enter any home you feel is unsafe.
- Let your parents know where you are going to be at all times and advise them if you will be late returning.

## Parents

- Be certain that young trick-or-treaters are accompanied by an adult. Older children should stay in groups.
- Pre-determine boundaries to trick-or-treat within, and establish a firm time to return home.
- Advise children not to eat anything until they return home. Dispose of any items that appear to have been tampered with, or that are not properly wrapped.

## Costumes

- Choose bright colored costumes that are highly visible. Adding reflective tape to costumes further increases visibility.
- Consider sending your children with a flashlight for additional safety and increased visibility.
- When purchasing, or making costumes, look for materials and accessories that are labeled flame-resistant.
- All costume accessories, such as sticks, rods, or wands, should be soft and flexible, with no sharp edges.
- Consider using hypoallergenic make-up kits instead of masks that may impair breathing, or vision.
- Be sure costumes are loose enough to be worn over warm clothing, but not so long that they become a tripping hazard. Costumes should not be longer than your child's ankles.
- Ensure your child is wearing adequate foot wear that takes into consideration weather conditions and walking.
