## Cold weather safety

Alberta Health Services EMS responds to many cold weather related emergencies every winter. Simple actions such as dressing appropriately and anticipating sudden weather changes can help keep you both warm and safe this season.

### Frostnip

- Frostnip occurs when skin is extremely cold, but not frozen. It commonly affects the ears, nose, cheeks, fingers and toes.
- The skin appears red but also turns to white when pressed. It may feel numb to the touch.
- When treated promptly, frost-nipped skin will heal without complication.
- Gently re-warming the affected area in a warm environment is advised.

### Frostbite

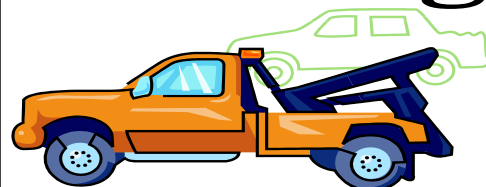
- Frostbite is when skin becomes so cold, the skin and underlying tissue freeze completely.
- It may look white and waxy and will feel hard to the touch.
- Treatment begins with removal from the cold environment and placing the affected area in warm, *not hot*, water (about 41°C) until re-warmed.
- Seek further medical attention as required.

### Hypothermia

- Hypothermia is abnormally low body temperature (less than 34°C as compared to normal body temperature of about 37°C).
- People suffering hypothermia may act inappropriately with uncharacteristic stumbling, mumbling, and fumbling, as their body temperature continues to lower.
- Early recognition and prompt medical attention is crucial. Left untreated, hypothermia may progress to coma and death.
- Call 9-1-1. Don't forget to protect yourself from the factors that originally lead to the patient's situation.
- Gentle re-warming should start as quickly as possible including: removal of wet or constrictive clothing, covering with blankets or sleeping bags, and protecting the patient from further heat loss (wind, moisture and contact with cold surfaces).

Hello hello,

My name is Isaac Tyler and I am one of the staff members at the Evergreen Youth Centre. I work every Saturday from 3pm-10 pm with the Gentlemen of Evergreen (Youth Boys ages 12-17) and this is my first article for the newsletter – hopefully the first of many!

I thought I would use this article as a way to introduce myself and

all of those involved in the program, as well as introduce our goal for the boys and update you as to our program's schedule. As I mentioned, my name is Isaac and I am 23 years old. I am currently in my third year of a combined Native Studies/Education degree at the University of Alberta. If you see a tall guy with dreadlocks around Evergreen on Saturdays, that's me! I began working in Evergreen at the skatepark as a Youth Worker for the City of Edmonton during the summer of 2008 and it was a great summer. I returned to the Evergreen skatepark in the summer of 2010 once again and was asked by Alice at the end of August if I would be interested in starting a Saturday Youth program. Needless to say, I've been here ever since!

My friend Adam Ward also works with the Youth on Saturdays. Adam is 21 and is also at the University of Alberta in his last year of an Education degree. Adam was also working at EG in the summer of 2010 and joined the Saturday Youth program later that December (Adam is the short Asian guy, known by the youth as "Tokyo Express").

And of course ya'll already know Alice – the wonderful lady that keeps everything running smoothly at the Youth Centre. Whether it's drawing up permission slips for field trips or running out to grab us some program supplies, she can also be found maintaining the building, attending board meetings and taking care of whatever else needs to be done. For the past few years the three of us have been working together to develop the best program that we can for the Youth.

Now that I've introduced Adam and myself I'll try to

explain a little more about our program and what we do. We call our group the Gentlemen of Evergreen. I have always addressed the boys as 'Gentlemen' and so the name kind of stuck. We also picked this name to represent our goal which is to help develop these awesome youth into young Gentlemen who are both kind and respectful. I have already seen really great things happening with each one of our guys. Last June the boys raised enough money through bottle collecting to pay for a weekend camping trip to Elk Island National Park. It was awesome! The guys worked hard to pitch their own tents, build their own fires and cook all their own food, but really enjoyed themselves while doing it. We also hope to encourage the building of life long skills. Once a month we plan a cooking Day. Just this past Saturday we had an Asian Theme where we cooked fried rice and the boys got to cook their choice of beef, chicken, pork, or shrimp to go with it. However, we do like to have a little fun in the process. The one thing that has made our group infamous around the Evergreen community is our NERF WARS. Almost every Saturday you can see about 15-18 youth running around the playground, parking lot and skating rink shooting each other with NERF guns. It's a blast, but I should warn you we take our NERF wars very seriously...very.

I am happy to say our group continues to grow and we are beginning to see more and more guys coming out on Saturdays! Even on our smallest days we have at least 12 boys showing up and we are hoping to break 20 very soon. It is really encouraging to have such great results and we hope it continues to be as successful as it has been.

problem of bullying.

Be a good example for your chil-

dren. Model respectful be-  
haviors at home and in your  
daily interactions.

Be treated fairly and with respect,

### Your responsibilities are to:
