Clareview District Park Development

Several exciting projects are now underway at Clareview District Park. The City of Edmonton is developing and constructing outdoor sports fields, park spaces and a multi-purpose recreation centre.

Edmonton Catholic Schools and the Edmonton Public Library are collaborating with the City to build a high school completion centre and the Clareview Library as part of the recreation centre— a first-of-its-kind facility in Edmonton.

These developments at Clareview District Park will combine to create a dynamic space full of activity, energy and vitality. A place where all will be welcome – a "community hub" where people of all ages and abilities can gather to learn, exercise, relax, meet and have fun.



Construction of the new recreation centre and library commenced in October 2011. The opening date is targeted for early 2014. The existing Branch Library and Gymnasium: arena and hall will close in April 2012 and reopen in 2013.

'Keep it light' on garbage day

Heavy bags unsafe for you and your collector

Many of us complain about taking out the garbage, but imagine doing it 600 times in one day.

For City garbage and recycling collectors, it's all part of a day's job. They pick up between 7,000 to 11,000 kilograms of waste every day – about the weight of 10 sub compact cars.

To give collectors and yourself a break, the City of Edmonton is encouraging you to 'Keep It Light' when you bag your garbage.

A good rule of thumb is that if you find it difficult to pick up, or have to drag it to the curb, it's probably too heavy.

City bylaw states your garbage bag or can must weigh less than 20 kilograms (44 pounds) or collectors will not

pick it up. Garbage cans must be less than 100 litres in size, with fixed handles, no wheels and a tight-fitting, removable lid.

This one easy step can help your collectors do their job better and pre vent you and your collector from injury.





Backyard Play Safety



Water hazards

- Ensure all backyard swimming pools are fenced. The fence should be at least 1.5 metres (5 feet) high and have a selflatching, self-closing, lockable gate;
- Drowning is the leading cause of unintentional injury-related death among children ages one to four;
- Children can drown in just a few centimetres of water if it covers their mouth and nose.

Lawn and garden tools

- Keep young children away from outdoor power equipment. Serious burns may result from touching hot engine surfaces;
- Ensure that all tools, fuel, chemicals, and other hazardous substances are stored in a secure, locked area. A simple latch may not be sufficient.

Insect bites and stings

- Minimize the risk of attracting insects by not wearing strong perfumes or scented lotions:
- Avoid wearing brightly coloured clothing outdoors;
- Destroy or re-locate hives and nests situated near your home;
- · To avoid a bite in case of accidentally stepping on a stinging insect always ensure you child wears shoes or
- If your child has received an 'EpiPenJr' prescription from your physician (for serious anaphylactic emergencies only) ensure they understand when and how to use it:
- If your child experiences a severe reaction to an insect sting, seek medical attention or call 9-1-1.

Ingredients 2 tablespoons sesame seeds 1 tablespoon poppy seeds 1/2 cup white sugar

1/2 cup olive oil
1/4 cup distilled white vinegar
1/4 teaspoon paprika
1/4 teaspoon Worcestershire sauce
1 tablespoon minced onion
10 ounces fresh spinach - rinsed,
dried and torn into bite-size pieces
1 quart strawberries - cleaned,
hulled and sliced
1/4 cup almonds, blanched and slivered

Directions

In a medium bowl, whisk together the sesame seeds, poppy seeds, sugar, olive oil, vinegar, paprika, Worcestershire sauce and onion. Cover, and chill for one hour. In a large bowl, combine the spinach, strawberries and almonds. Pour dressing over salad, and toss. Refrigerate 10 to 15 minutes before serving.
